YOUNG ADULT MISSION TRIP TO YELLOWKNIFE AND FORT PROVIDENCE

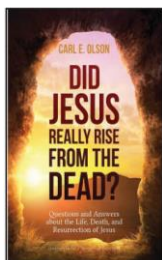
