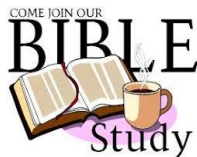


### CWL POINSETTIA SALE:

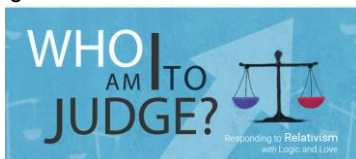
