Family of Faith

Thank you for your continued support of the Family of Faith Campaign. Our parish has met the goal of the Archdiocese by raising \$945,000. This means the parish is now receiving 75% of all donations. We just received our 5th allocation of funds in the amount of \$160,798.25. As per policy 50% of this amount (\$80,399.12) was applied to the Parish Debt and the other 50% was credited to the Parish Family of Faith Account. These funds will be directed to address the ongoing maintenance of our building especially the furnace systems and to enhance our youth ministry
