This line is appearing more and more on many doors of businesses and offices. As we experience higher attendance in our church, we will also introduce this kind of approach so that people do not feel that we are turning them away from church.

Our present capacity is one third of the spaces available - which would be about 225. But in practical terms to accommodate everyone with proper social distancing - we can accommodate maximum 170 people at any Mass celebration.

We do have an effective way to register for Mass and reserve your place through our website called Eventbrite. This is necessary so that people feel safe and assured of space. The information is also necessary for contact tracing.

We did accommodate some “walk - ins” in the past - but considering coming feasts - we will not accept anyone without registration.

Therefore, our church worship will be “BY APPOINTMENT ONLY”.

We take this step seriously as we want to make sure that we can properly accommodate people without disappointments - and turning them away. We also adhere to strict distancing, mandatory masks, and proper cleaning and sanitizing procedures.

We thank all our ushers and “sanitizing” people for their commitment and hard work. And we thank all of you for your understanding and support.
