MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR



In today's Gospel we talk about talents: As the Christmas season approaches many stores play Christmas songs. One of

them is the "Little Drummer Boy".

The song was written in 1941 and it revolves around a little boy who is called upon, quite unexpectedly, to pay homage to the newborn Savior in the town of Bethlehem.

The problem for little boy was that he was poor with no gift to bring. All this boy could offer was his simple talent, namely to 'play a drum'. So he played for Him (Baby Jesus). The song ends with the words "then He smiled at me pa rum, pum pum, pum, me and my drum".

Everyone has a talent to give which is a gift for Jesus. Jesus will smile on you too. Ministry work is an opportunity for you to use your talents.
