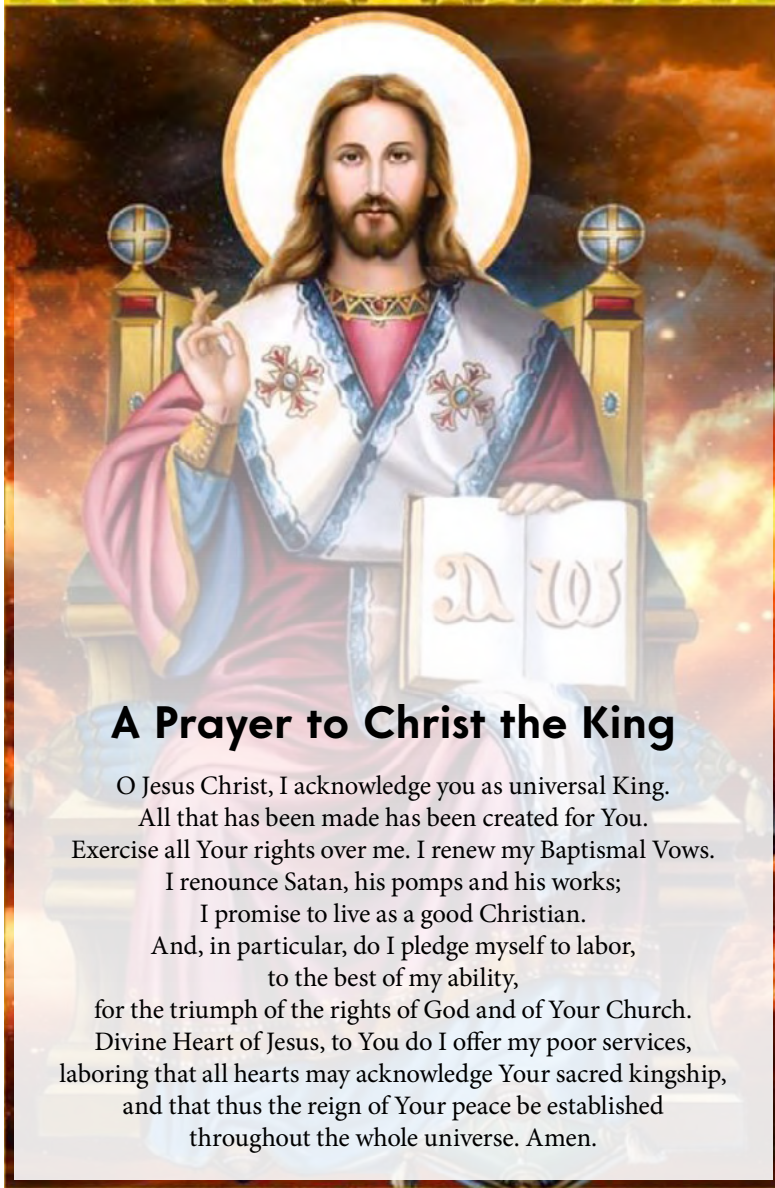




# ST. JUSTIN MARTYR PARISH
