


ST. JUSTIN MARTYR PARISH

SOME FACTS ABOUT LENT



Lent is the 40-day period from Ash Wednesday to Easter Sundays). (exclude The English word Lent is a

shortened form of Old English word lencten, which means "spring season".

Lent began in the 4th century AD and its focus was following the teachings and examples of Jesus in self-denial in preparation for Easter such as Jesus's fasting in the desert for 40 days and Jesus' teaching, "If any want to become my followers, let them deny

themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me." (Luke 9:23).

Three major spiritual activities during Lent are: Prayer: Stations of the Cross, the Rosary, and

Divine Mercy Chaplet

Fasting/Abstaining: Fasting from food abstaining from meat is practiced especially on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of year. Catholics over 14 years old are called to abstain from

meat and those between 18 to 59 are called to fast from food. Exceptions are those who are nursing a child, or in jobs with physical labour, or those who are sick.

Catholic also give up or limit themselves from things that they enjoy: internet, coffee, video games, Netflix, KFC (Korean Fried Chicken), Everything in moderation!

"All things are lawful for me,' but not all things are helpful. 'All things are lawful for me,' but I will not be dominated by anything." (1 Cor 6:12)

Almsgiving: We are not fasting or sacrificing to simply deny ourselves. Fasting is a means to an end, not an end in itself. Our goal is to make sacrifices to help others by sharing our resources.
We should give alms to those in need. But this also

means that we should spend more time with God and with our family.

Covid-19 & Lent: Lent has become difficult due to pandemic. It might be simpler to work on the basics by daily practicing - daily Prayer, daily Bible reading, patience at home, work, grocery store, or on the road, Kindness to those around us, especially our family members, thoughtfulness towards our neighbours and especially those in need etc.
