Communication On this Sunday, Paul was shown as an extra ordinary communicator of Faith. His focus was on:

a) message, b) mission c) method d) motive

The message is that Jesus is the one who heals broken hearted, who lifts the downtrodden and loves all of us no matter what. "Jesus is the Message".

The **mission** is to let all know and the **method** is to use all means: books, printing, radio, TV, computer, all being gifts of God. We can use these effectively. But most fundamental communication tool is the person of faith- We are the medium. What message do we convey? The **motive** is to love and communicate with your God, with your family with your world.

I said to myself: "I should improve my communication skills with God, with family and with the world".

Disciples came and said, "everyone is looking for you". That reminds us about the story when relatives came and said, "we would like to see Jesus". "Hey Jesus, everyone is looking for you".

Why were they looking for Jesus? They were trying to solve their problems by looking for Jesus. We are on the same boat, we are looking for Jesus, looking for something and sometimes we don't even know what we are looking for...

People are generally shy to admit that they are looking into something spiritual. We propose to have "spiritual events" where we can share faith and hear others. It is also in the simple acts of kindness where we will find Jesus.

Where God can be found. Where would you look for Jesus? Where God can be found? He can be found in silence and in loneliness and in meditation.
