FROM OUR PASTOR Epiphany: The Journey of Three Wise Men

Epiphany is a story of three wise men of the

East. A summary of this feast would be fourfold:

- ✓ **Pilgrimage of life**: This is a success story of the search. They set out on a journey to find God and they did! What are you searching? Do you ever search for God, and if so, where would your pilgrimage take you?
- ✓ He who seeks finds! These wise men of the East found God who is personal, knowable, and recognizable.
- ✓ Star of life: There are many theories about astrology from such old cultures as the Egyptians, Assyrians, Persians and Chinese to name few. All of them talk about stars and constellations, but my grandmother had a theory of her own: "you cannot see the star of Bethlehem by binoculars- you have to look for it inside of you". There is a star in every person and for every person. And if you follow that star, you will find that what wise men of the East found: they found God.
- ✓ **Different way**: When you find Jesus of Bethlehem, you will be led to take a different route, a different way of life, different style and different values. It is no longer about old ways…but a new way!

If there is one thing to learn from this great feast is that God is revealing himself. He can be found by following the star. This might change our travel plans. But would you be willing to accept this change and follow God's chosen path?
