FROM OUR PASTOR: "HOME"



As we are in this strict lockdown with "stay at home" orders from the health and civic authorities, we could reflect at our home base.

A home is where we live, a

home is where we love, a home is where we rest, a home is where we grow. A home is not just a space or building or dwelling. True home is all the above and more. It must have a heart.

People love their homes for many reasons including memories. They define the places that are important because of their relationship to them. A home is a little church where we receive love. School is where we learn, hospital is place of healing and so on. These days we are "tired" of being home, but this should bring us to new appreciation of our homes and families.

In this Sunday gospel John's disciples ask Jesus: Rabbi, where do you live? He invited them "Come and see". Jesus invites us to "come and see" His place, His way, His ambiance, His domain where there is order, goodness, forgiveness, patience and respect. If we have little bit more of that in our own homes - what a blessing that would be.

At his time of the year, it is custom in some countries to bless homes by a priest. But we cannot do it in these circumstances. But you yourself can bless your family and your home. You can create your own prayer or search for one on internet.

I am recommending the usage of this prayer, customized for home use:

"Blessed are you, Lord God, King of the universe, You have graced this family with this home. Bless us and bless our home. May we be people of prayer and peace. May we live in your love and be generous in our service to others. May the faith of Mary and Joseph and all your saints inspire us to follow the example of your Son Jesus who is our Lord and savior for ever and ever. Amen".
