Message from our Pastor: Palm Sunday



We are now into Holy Week - this is culmination of our faith celebration: we focus on life, death

and resurrection of Jesus.

Every Palm Sunday we would start with procession and solemn blessing of palms. This year we are limited to small numbers and handing out palms at the end of mass.

The story of Palm Sunday tells of how people removed their cloaks and spread them out in front of Jesus as he entered Jerusalem. The cloak we wear every day to face the world is both the persona we wish to present, and our defense against the elements. As we come to worship may we be willing to lay down our defenses and disguises, at the feet of the One who sees us as we really are. And then, set free for worship, may we offer our praises with open hearts.

If not, there is still time to pray, reflect and connect. If you are late into this simply say a prayer this week in the morning and at evening and reflect on the story of The Passion. These times are not to be just depressing - but moments of growth and strength and love.
