
ST. JUSTIN MARTYR PARISH

PAPAL VISIT TO CANADA

The Vatican issued the following statement regarding future visit to Canada by the Holy Father. The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops has invited the Holy Father to make an apostolic

journey to Canada. His Holiness has indicated his willingness to visit the country on a date to be settled in due course.

An excerpt from the Statement of Cardinal Thomas Collins regarding Announcement of Papal Visit to Canada:

"I am most grateful that Pope Francis has accepted the invitation of the Bishops of Canada for a pastoral visit to advance the healing and reconciliation journey with the indigenous peoples of the land."

And it continues there after as stated by Cardinal Collins: "I invite the faithful of the Archdiocese of Toronto to join me in prayer for all those who suffer from the legacy of the residential school system. We pray also for the delegates who will visit with the Holy Father in December. Finally, we keep Pope Francis close in prayer. May he be blessed with good health and strength to prepare him to join us at the appropriate moment to continue our journey of healing and reconciliation together."
