


ST. JUSTIN MARTYR PARISH

THE SYMBOLISM OF ADVENT WREATH



The Advent Wreath is one of the oldest and most popular Christmas raditions. It is displayed during the period

that includes the four Sundays before the feast of the Nativity. The Wreath represents the cycle of thousands of years from Adam to Jesus during which the world awaited the coming of the Redeemer. It teaches us many lessons:-

The Circle: Without beginning or end, teaches us that God and the joy of eternity never end.

The Evergreen: Symbol of life, is a reminder that the Lord Jesus is our life and that he remains present among us. He is our hope for salvation as green is the Church's colour for hope. The evergreen never changes, so also God's love for us never changes.

The Candles: Symbolize the light of grace that was given to all people when our Saviour was born. They tell us that Jesus who is coming is our light. They have little meaning unless they are lighted. With the flame they become alive, they give light and warmth. In their own way, they remind us that Jesus is living and that he is coming to give us light and life. As Jesus' coming draws near, the brightness increases. The purple candles, like the purple vestments worn by the priest, remind us that it is a penitential season, a time of penance and mortification, however, the rose candle brightens this season indicating our joy that the Lord is near.
