In today's first reading we hear of a wealthy woman who would stop and provide a meal to the prophet Elisha whenever she saw him walking by. She recognized him to be a

holy man and decided to go even more out of her way by providing a furnished room from Elisha to stay. This woman used her gifts and possessions to serve others. This should serve as a model of stewardship for all of us.

Let us ask ourselves, how do we use our gifts to serve others? The woman in the reading is described to be wealthy, so she was able to give from her material wealth to support the prophet. However, while we may not have the same material wealth as this woman, we all possess the wealth of our time. As stewards we should reflect on how we can use our time to serve Christ and the church. Perhaps one way is by offering our time to help with various ministries that take place over the summer months at the parish.

The reading tells us that for her generosity, the woman was prophesized to soon bear her first child. We too as stewards can look forward to the reward of our labours. We will receive the gift of joy in this life as we work towards the ultimate reward of eternal union with God in heaven.

Nov. 23 Upon morning arrival in Tel Aviv we are transferred to Aqaba in Jordan. Time for rest, dinner and overnight.

Nov. 24 In the morning we travel to Wadi Rum, one of the world's outstanding desert landscapes to observe local li and Bedouin culture. This is where the movie "Lawrence of Arabia" was made in 1962. We have a tradition Bedouin lunch in one of their tents. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Nov. 25 Today we travel to Petra, world's wonder and Jordan's most valuable treasure. The city was carved into the sheer rock face by Nabataeans, settled 2000 years ago and made an important junction for silk, spice ar other trade routes linking China and India with Egypt, Greece and Rome. We visit the Treasury, Monaste and amphitheater. Late afternoon continue to our hotel in Amman for dinner and overnight.

Nov. 26 This morning we depart to visit other treasures of Jordan. We visit Madaba, best known for its Byzantine ar Umayyad mosaics and stop at Mt. Nebo where Moses saw the Promised Land for the first time. La afternoon we cross the Jordan River and move on to Jericho for dinner and overnight.

Nov. 27 Today we explore the area of Jordan Valley. We leave for a full day excursion to the Dead Sea and Qumra Time for floating in the Dead Sea and visit Jericho, the oldest inhabited city in the world where we celebra Mass and enjoy the views from Mt. of Temptation. We stop at the Jordan River in Qasr al-Yahud, whe Jesus was baptized. Dinner and overnight.

Nov. 28 After breakfast we depart to Galilee. En route we ascend Mount Tabor - the Mount of the Transfiguratio Continue to Cana - the site of Jesus' first miracle. Here we celebrate a marriage renewal ceremony. We move on to Nazareth where we celebrate Mass at the Basilica of the Annunciation and we visit Mary's Well and S Joseph's Carpentry Shop. Dinner and overnight in our hotel Nazareth.

Nov. 29 After breakfast we depart for Tiberias. We travel by boat on the Sea of Galilee, visit Capernaum, home of S Peter and the site of Jesus' preaching, on to Tabgha to see the Church of the Multiplication with its beautif 5th century fish mosaic. We also visit the Church of the Primacy and celebrate Mass on the Mount of the Beatitudes. After visiting archeological site of Magdala, town of Mary Magdalen we return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Today we visit Cesarea Philippi, where Jesus revealed to His disciples for the first time that He was indee Nov. 30 Messiah. Continue to Tel Dan Nature Reserve, one of the most important sites in the ancient Near Eas situated at the base of snow-capped Mount Hermon on the headwaters of the Jordan. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Dec. 01 This morning we depart Galilee for Judea and the area of Jerusalem. En route we visit via Cesarea by the Sea and stop in the old town of Jaffa where we celebrate Mass. Continue via Ein Karem, the town of St. Joh the Baptist to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

Dec. 02 In the morning we depart to Mount of Olives in Jerusalem and visit Garden of Gethsamene, Church of A Nations, Pater Noster and Dominus Flevit churches. Continue to Mount Zion with the Upper Room (Room the Last Supper) and the Church of St. Peter's in Gallicantu. In the afternoon we visit Bethlehem - whe Jesus was born, celebrating Mass in one of the churches. We visit the Manger, the Crusaders' Cloister ar the Grotto of St. Jerome - Shepherd's field. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Today's journey takes us to the ancient city of Jerusalem: St. Ann's Church, Pool of Bethesda, Pilate Judgment Hall, the Chapel of the Flagellation and the Arch of Ecce Homo, the convent of the sisters of Zio We continue with the Stations of the Cross - Via Dolorosa to the Holy Sepulchre. Mass will be celebrated in or of the many churches of Jerusalem. In the afternoon we visit the Western Wall, also called the "Wailing Wall". V see the place of the Mosque of Omar and El Aksar. Return to hotel for dinner and overnight.

Dec. 04 In the morning we are transferred to the airport in Tel Aviv for a flight to Toronto. Afternoon arrival.
