STEWARDSHIP BULLETIN REFLECTIONS A Season of Evangelization



In the Gospel this Second Sunday of Advent (Luke 3.1-6) we hear about the proclamation of John the Baptist. John's

vocation in life was to "prepare the way of the Lord, [and] make his paths straight." He played the vital role of closing out the line of prophets that all pointed to Jesus. As stewards, all of us are called in a similar way to imitate John the Baptist and point others to Christ.
