STEWARDSHIP REFLECTIONS Reflect

This Sunday, one central theme that runs through all of the readings is that of evangelization. St. Paul in his letter to the Corinthians says "woe to me if I do not proclaim the Gospel!" At the end of the Gospel reading today it says that "Jesus went throughout Galilee proclaiming the message in their synagogues." St. Francis Xavier says that "many, many people hereabouts are not becoming Christians for one reason only: there is nobody to make them Christians." As stewards, evangelization is one of our core responsibilities so let us take some time to reflect on how we can offer our time and talents to this important work.

Firstly, in order for us to encourage people to follow Christ, we must take the time to journey with them. This is perhaps the most important gift we can offer someone as we evangelize. Jesus often spent His time conversing and interacting with the people of Judea. We too should follow this practice and intentionally make an effort to spend time with those whom we know are away from the faith. It is in these interactions that they will be able to see the joy and love that emanates from the presence of Christ within us.

Secondly, as stewards we are invited to perform concrete actions to help bring others to Christ. St. Teresa of Avila says that "we must all try to be preachers through our deeds." By performing selfless acts of love we can point others to Love Himself and help them come to know Jesus. Therefore, as stewards, let us take the time and effort to intentionally share the Gospel through our daily witness.

The year in review - 2023

Despite the challenges we are all experiencing these days, the Society of Saint Vincent de Paul continues to assist our neighbours in need in the parish community from the donations we received from our generous donors at the church.

The St. Justin Martyr Conference regularly provides food voucher assistance to over 30 families, including 38 children and 48 adults, in our community, for a total of 250 home visits. These families, without your donations, would likely struggle to put food on their tables and provide for their children. Your generous donations to the Society bring them hope for a better future for their families.

Twice a year, we conduct bundle up weekends, where we collect gently used clothing, and this event is a popular and successful activity at our parish. We were able to fill the container both times.

We have been able to provide diapers, clothing, a laptop and some furniture to our Neighbours in Need. When we received special requests from our families, we placed these requests in the bulletin and thanks to generous donors, we were able to provide.

In August, thanks to the generosity of our parishioners, we were able to distribute Walmart gift cards to families with children to assist in purchasing school supplies.

In October, three of our local schools collected winter coats that were distributed to Neighbours in Need in our community, before the cold weather arrived.

In December, with the help of the Caring and Sharing Program, we were able to distribute No Frills and Walmart gift cards to the families for Christmas, so they could experience the joy of the season.

We continue to contribute funding to St. Lucy's Conference, our twinning conference in St Lucia, and St. Boniface Conference, in Toronto. They are very grateful for our consistent assistance.

Outside of the work we do in our conference, we also support Society of Saint Vincent de Paul programs in Toronto: Emergency Shelters for Women in Crisis, Recovery Housing, Supportive Housing, Stores Division and Court Services.

Our mission is to serve Christ through our Neighbours in Need with love, respect, justice, and joy. At the heart of our work are home visits, facilitated by committed volunteers from our parish, to provide support and friendship. Last year we conducted a recruitment drive and received several names of parishioners that will potentially become members and help our efforts. This generosity brings us hope.

Special thanks to Monsignor Vid Vlasic, the Catholic Women's League and Caring and Sharing for their continuous support.

Please continue to pray for our volunteers and the Neighbours in Need.
