

NORTH 60 FOOD DRIVE 2024 Collection Until June 14, 2024



In cooperation with SSVP, our parish is participating in the North 60 Initiative to collect food for the community of Taloyoak in Nunavut. Taloyoak is the most

northern community in mainland Canada and is only accessible by air and an annual sea container delivery. Food prices in communities north of the 60th parallel are exorbitant and these communities depend on help for their winter food supplies.

This year, we are looking for 5 and 10 lb. bags of flour, baking powder, salt, dried fruits (raisins, cranberries, apricots, figs, etc.) canned vegetables and canned corn. If you wish to being in items, kindly look for longer expiry dates and drop them in the Food Basket near the Tree of Life in the Church foyer. We need to ensure that what we provide is useful for the needy. Thank you for your generosity.
