



STEWARDSHIP REFLECTIONS Recognizing the Risen Lord



Rejoice, the Lord is risen, truly He is risen! Today is the Solemnity of Solemnities, the most holy day in the Church's calendar. Let us take a moment to rejoice in the glory of the resurrection.

These past forty days we've been preparing for this great feast where we will be met with the risen Christ. However, let us ask ourselves, how often do we fail to recognize Him in our daily lives?

In the Gospel on Easter Sunday, we hear the account of Jesus appearing to Mary Magdalene. Mary is faceto face with Jesus risen from the dead and yet she didn't recognize Him. She has spent the last couple years of her life following Him and now she cannot even identify Him as the man before her.

While we may be quick to judge Mary, we should remember that Christ makes Himself present to us in countless ways that we often don't perceive. One way that Jesus comes to us is through our neighbour.

St. Teresa of Calcutta says "I see Jesus in every human being. I say to myself, this is hungry Jesus, I must feed him. This is sick Jesus. This one has leprosy or gangrene; I must wash him and tend to him. I serve because I love Jesus."
