

STEWARDSHIP BULLETIN REFLECTIONS Pressing On Towards the Goal




As we quickly approach Holy Week, let us take a moment to reflect on how we are using this time of Lent to renew our zeal for stewardship. In the second reading

this Sunday (Philippians 3.8-14) we hear St. Paul say, "I press on toward the goal for the prize of the heavenly call of God in Christ Jesus." We can learn a lot from this image of constantly moving forward towards the prize of our heavenly reward.
