


ST. JUSTIN MARTYR PARISH

STEWARDSHIP BULLETIN REFLECTIONS **Persevering in Our Mission**

In the Gospel this Sunday (Luke 9.51-62) we hear the following passage: "When the days drew near for him to be taken up, Jesus set his face to go to Jerusalem." As Jesus' passion on Calvary loomed nearer He did not shy away from His mission, but rather, He firmly fixed His gaze on accomplishing what He was sent out to do. This is the model that we should follow as stewards.

Our mission is to gratefully and generously offer our time and talents to our parish community as a means of serving Christ and the Church. While our stewardship will undoubtedly be filled with many moments of great peace and joy, we are also sure to experience moments of hardship. We may experience the temptation of giving up or making excuses as to why we shouldn't continue to serve. We may also be afraid of the crosses that arise during our apostolates.

Jesus too was aware of the great cross and suffering that lay in the horizon of His mission. Despite all this, He remained steadfast. We should pray to God every day, asking Him for the strength to persevere in our call of stewardship. Even in difficult moments, let us readily turn to God. St. John Paul II encourages us saying, "Don't be afraid of the radicalness of His demands... If He asks much of you it is because He knows you can give much." The Lord has great plans to use us as missionary disciples, we just need to say yes to His invitation.



MASS ETIQUETTE



Often times, as parishioners, volunteers, as members of the Church, we need to remind ourselves that Church Masses are feasts, given to us by our Holy God. It is a privilege to

attend this feast that we are called for. Here are some points to consider while you come for Masses.

- Be on time. Coming early and getting seated with reverence helps prepare yourself for the Mass. Late arrivals can be disruptive for the congregation.
- Eucharist Is Jesus. We believe in the "Real Presence" of Jesus in the Eucharist and be in a state of grace to receive Holy Communion.
- Observe Eucharistic Fast. Abstain from any food or drink for at least an hour before receiving Holy Communion. There are exceptions for water and medication, when required.
- Dress well to present yourself to Jesus! You are called for the banquet by our Lord. Our appearance and our approach should reflect this. Wear appropriate and dignified clothing, wear your Sunday best. It is recommended to avoid shorts, beach sandals, etc.
