

### STEWARDSHIP BULLETIN REFLECTIONS Giving Our First Fruits This Lent



As we enter into this Season of Lent, let us reflect on how we can best use this time to grow in our relationship with God and our commitment to

stewardship. In the first reading from the book of Deuteronomy (Deuteronomy 26.4-10), Moses instructs the people saying that when they come to give their offerings to God, they should "bring the first of the fruit of the ground." The Lord wants our very best, not what we have leftover.

This is very true in our lives as stewards. It's definitely good to offer up our time and talents to our parish community. However, do we only give from what we have remaining after all of our other priorities are taken care of? To serve the Gospel should always be of prime importance.

One Lenten resolution we can adopt to help us offer our "first fruits" is the practice of scheduling our time of prayer in advance. Prayer should not be an afterthought that we try to squeeze in when we have time. Instead, we should block out a chuck of time each day that is free from all other competing distractions and is reserved only for our conversation with God.

Let us strive to create a scheduled prayer life this Lent, perhaps starting with 10 minutes a day. If we do so, we will see great wonders take place in our relationship with God and others.

## "With Mary, Pilgrims of Hope" Pilgrimage to France & Spain

Under spiritual leadership of Fr. Ryan Nigli, Associate Pastor, St. Justin Martyr Parish in Unionville

November 3-14, 2025 - 12 days - \$4,990.00 (Toronto Dep. incl. all taxes and tips)



Nov. 03 Late evening departure from Toronto to Paris.

Late morning arrival in Paris. Upon arrival we are transferred to Lisieux, city of St. Thérèse, "The Little Flower" where we celebrate Mass in the Basilica dedicated to her. Continue to our hotel for dinner and overnight.



After breakfast we travel to Paris. Upon arrival we visit the Basilica of Sacré Coeur de Montmartre where we celebrate Mass. Some free time before transfer to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Today our tour of the city includes views of Eiffel Tower, Place de La Concorde and Champs-Elysées. We visit Notre Dame Cathedral (if available) and Miraculous Medal chapel where we celebrate Mass. In the afternoon sightseeing river boat on river Seine. Transfer to hotel for dinner and overnight.

This morning we depart to Nevers. Upon arrival we visit the chapel at St. Gildard church where St. Bernadette died in 1879 and was buried. We will have a chance to see and venerate her incorruptible body placed in a crystal coffin. Mass in the chapel. Then on to Paray-le-Monial to visit Basilica of Sacre Coeur and the Chapel of the Visitation. Continue to Macon for dinner and overnight

After breakfast we depart to Ars. En route we visit the famous Benedictine Abbey of Cluny. Then stop in nearby Taize, a center of ecumenical movement. Upon arrival in Ars we visit the Shrine of St. John Vianney where we celebrate Mass. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Today we travel to Avignon. On the way we stop in Lyon for a tour and a visit to the cathedral. Then continue through the peaceful landscape of Provence to Avignon, residence of Popes in the 14th century. We visit the ancient walled old town and the Cathedral of Avignon, where we have Mass before being transferred to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Morning departure to Lourdes, the birthplace of St. Bernadette to whom Our Lady appeared in 1858. En route we stop in Carcassonne, a mediaval town surrounded by ancient walls. Upon arrival in Lourdes Mass, dinner, rosary procession with candles and overnight.

Nov. 12 Nov. 13

Nov. 11 Full day in Lourdes. Time to visit the Grotto and the Basilicas. We have Mass and The Way of The Cross, time for individual prayer and bath, dinner and overnight.

Today we travel to Segovia in Spain. En route we stop in Burgos and visit the magnificent Gothic Cathedral and celebrate Mass. Continue to Segovia for dinner and overnight.

This morning we tour Segovia, a town rich in architectural legacy, including medieval walls, Romanesque churches, a former royal palace and a Gothic cathedral. Continue to Avila, the city of St. Teresa of Avila and St. John of the Cross where we celebrate Mass at the St. Teresa convent. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Nov. 14 This morning, we are transferred to Madrid airport for a flight to Toronto. Evening arrival.


