Summer Camp Anchored 2025 - Information Sheet

WHO

Camp *Anchored* is open to youth who will be entering into their Grade 1 to 5 year in September 2025. Those *entering* S. K. and Grade 6 in September 2025 are **not** eligible for camp.

Due to a capacity limit, registration will be by first-come, first-serve basis. A waitlist will be created upon reaching capacity.

The camp will be managed by the Youth Minister, under the direction of the Pastor. The camp will be facilitated by trained and screened high-school volunteer leaders and adult/parent volunteers.



WHAT



We are thrilled to be hosting a safe, fun, and faith-filled parish-based Catholic summer camp experience. Camp *Anchored* will explore what it means to live a life “anchored” in Jesus Christ. Teachings will be presented to youth in an accessible way through games, music, skits, activities, crafts, small groups, and more.

This year, our theme is *Sweetness of Faith: The Fruits of the Holy Spirit*. Camp *Anchored* will also guide youth to grow in devotion to **Our Lady of Mount Carmel**. Our camp will be rooted in the Eucharist through regular participation of the Holy Mass and Eucharistic Adoration.

WHEN

Camp *Anchored* is a 5-day summer camp. You may register for only **one week of camp**. The programming and content of both camp weeks will be the same.

- **Camp Week 1:** Monday, July 14th to Friday, July 18th
- **Camp Week 2:** Monday, July 21st to Friday, July 25th

Camp runs from **9:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.** Campers may be dropped off at 8:30 a.m. at the earliest and must be picked up at 2:30 p.m. A before/after camp program/supervision will **not** be available.

WHERE

Camp *Anchored* will take place at **St. Justin Martyr Catholic Church**. Some activities during the camp day may take place at the neighbourhood’s Sablewood Park (5 minute-walk, north of the church), or the field next to St. John XXIII Catholic Elementary School (10 minute-walk).
